- II. SBO Update – George Alexander, President and Tanner Johnson, Tech Officer
  - a. Riverton High Video presented –Riverton Is. . .
  - b. Overview of activities and events, past and future
  - c. Requested suggestions to be submitted to the SBO suggestion box located in main office
- III. Welcome & Introduction of Members/Purpose of Committee
  - a. Member introduction
  - b. Voting on Chair and other needed positions
    - i. Explanation of differences between Co-chair and Vice-Chair by Richard Titus
    - ii. All committee members voted in favor of having a Chair and Vice-chair
    - iii. Chair – Open for nominations
      1. Steve Johnson and Richard Titus nominated
      2. Steve Johnson voted in as Chair by a 8 to 7 vote
    - iv. Vice Chair – Open for nominations
      1. Richard Titus nominated, second; approved as Vice-chair unanimously
    - v. The needed quorum requirements for Council voting
      1. A quorum is  $\frac{1}{2} + 1$  of the whole council (8), and requires one more parent than teacher
      2. A quorum is required for a vote or to conduct business.
- IV. Fundraising Report
  - a. Required to have only one School Wide fundraiser – Silver Rush in December
  - b. Each organization must submit for approval through the District, Administrator of Schools, Teri Timpson before moving forward.

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- c. Current fundraising for RHS 2011 – 2012 is presented.
  - i. Request made to add a column of “actual revenue” collected after fundraiser completion
  - ii. Viability of fundraisers selected is discussed
    - 1. More discretion of funds and percentages earned by students is requested. Advisor over fundraiser should be required to take responsibility on accounting and anticipated revenue.
  - iii. FFA is discussed – 7 students qualified to go to Nationals in Indiana
  - iv. Athletic teams not sanctioned by the Utah High School Athletic Association (UHSAA) discussed
    - 1. Non-Sanctioned teams do not fall under the district requirements, including fundraising
    - 2. The use of RHS name for non-sanctioned teams is discussed
      - a. Council members agreed that it is not effective to try to manage and oversee the use of RHS name, and to allow this to continue as is.
    - 3. The difference between clubs and unsanctioned sports is discussed.
      - a. Explained as an insurance and liability issue
      - b. Also certain sports do not want to be sanctioned because of pay and restrictions
    - 4. NFHS – must be used to sell any high school and team logo items. RHS does get small compensation through the NFHS for the sale of logo items
  - v. Motion made to approve fundraising, second; passed unanimously
- V. Students taking online classes instead of Riverton classes, update
  - a. Utah State legislation has changed
    - i. Funding always follows students.
    - ii. Student taking online courses must take a minimum of 6 courses in the school
    - iii. Student is allowed to take a maximum 2 state approved online courses
  - b. Jordan District has entered into a partnership with a group of other Utah School Districts, to allow students to take online courses, not available through Jordan District, from these partner districts. Student funding stays with their “home” district.
    - i. Student works through school counselors to register for online courses of any state approved course.
    - ii. Less than 20 students are taking online courses at RHS
    - iii. Students must be on Home Release or in the online learning labs, which is in the Media Center and supervised by the Media Center faculty.
    - iv. Significant increase in enrollees and the issues that may arise is discussed.
  - c. Dual enrollment is discussed
    - i. Jordan District Policy is that students must have a minimum of 6 classes in a Jordan District School and cannot be dually enrolled in two state funded schools at one time
    - ii. Students who do not comply will be withdrawn
- VI. Public School Data Gateway from USOE(PSD)- on state USOE schools.utah.gov is shown and discussed
- VII. Future Meeting Schedule discussed
  - a. Minimum of 4 meetings per school year is required although can meet as many times as needed
  - b. Meetings for the year are scheduled:
    - i. Jan 11, 2012
    - ii. March 14, 2012
    - iii. April 25, 2012

- VIII. Land Trust Video and Explanation of these Funds 2011-12 Plan
  - a. Moved to move this discussion to next meeting, second; passed unanimously
  - b. Council members are asked to view Land Trust video before next meeting
